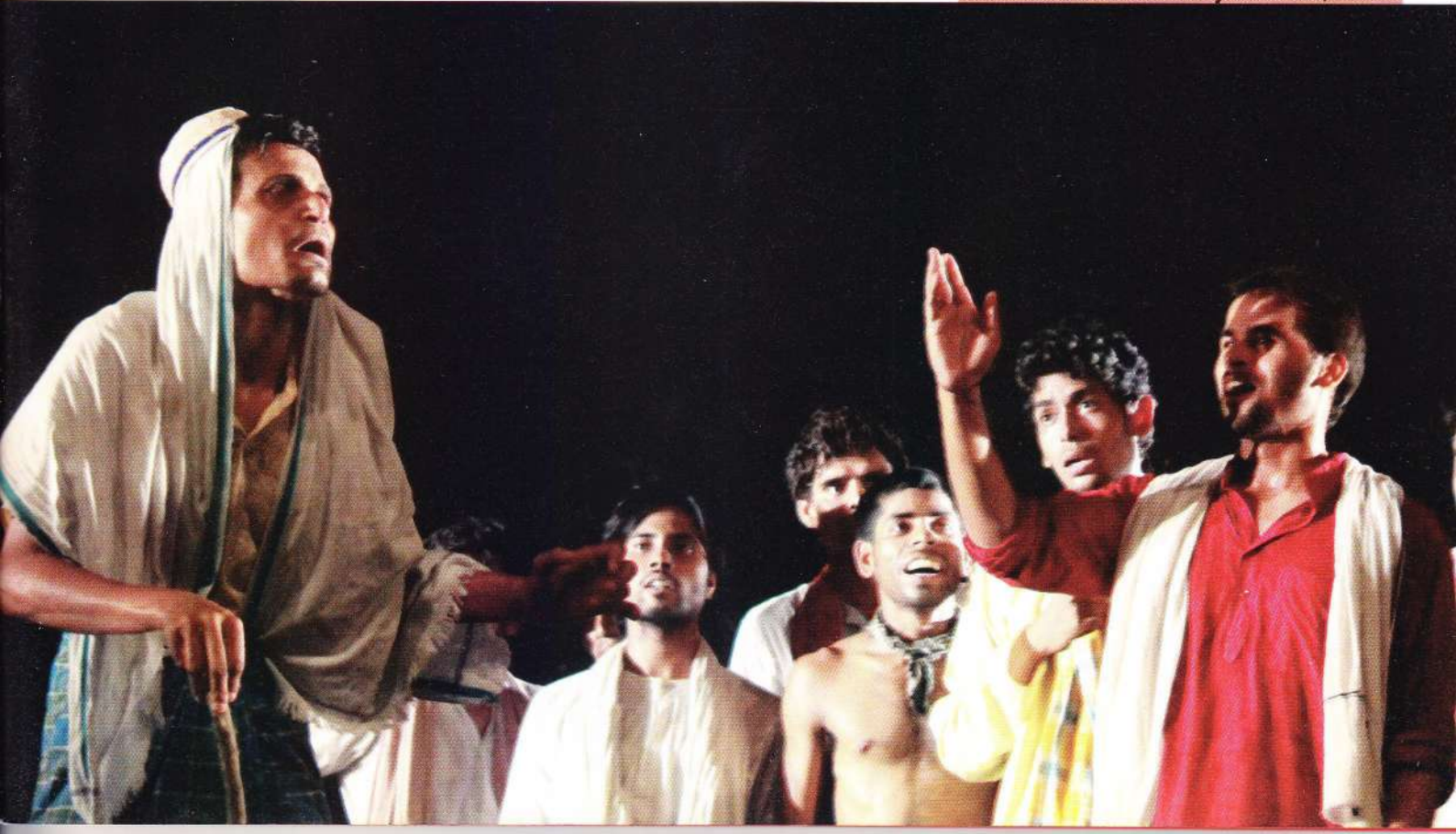

As the play begins Jessie asks for her father's service revolver and calmly announces that she intends to kill herself. At first her mother refuses to take her seriously, but as Jessie sets about tidying the house and making lists of things to be looked after, her sense of desperate helplessness begins to build.

Director's Note :

Ho Rahega..... was an unusual and not so safe choice as a play but the honesty and realistic treatment attracted me to infuse life into this. Thought provoking play is comparable to a Greek tragedy. The major challenges were to keep it crisp and fresh in spite of the disturbing subject and also highlight the light moments which were laced with dark humor. The purpose of the play is to force the audience to seriously think about meaning of life, honesty in relationships, need to take responsibility of one's actions and courage.

At the end of the 2 weeks, however, Helen has learned to dress herself, eat with a fork, and understand the alphabet of touch.

Director's Note :

"Helen" is about the moment that we all dream: when we tear up unexpectedly because something we've just seen or heard ignites our deepest desires of accomplishment. This play is often mistaken for the story of Helen Keller. It is not. This is a period in the life of Anne Sullivan. 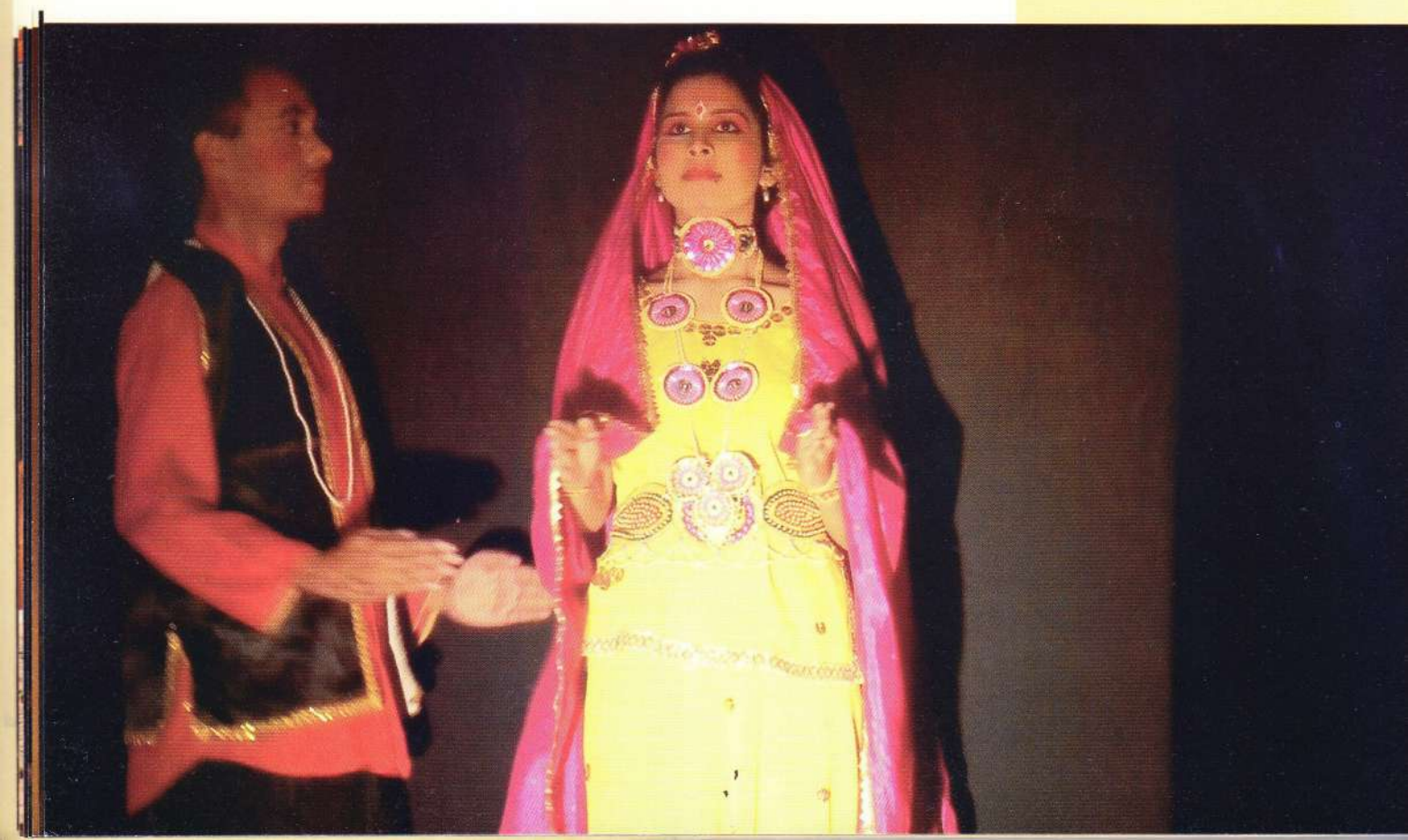
Director's Note :

Due to her mother's death, MEERAn went to live at her grandfather's palace MERTA at the age of seven. His name was Rao Duda and he was the emperor of MERTA. Once seeing a BAARAT crossing nearby, MEERAn innocently asked to her grandmother "MERA DULHA KAUN HAI". She replied, KRISHNA is your DULHA. Since then she started believing in lord KRISHNA. At the age of 13, she got married to BHOJRAJ who was elder son of RANA SANGA the empor of CHITTORE. Bhojraj died only 8 years after their marriage.

His younger brother VIKRAMADITYA and sister UDABAI started torturing MEERAn for believing in lord KRISHNA and not praying to Kuldevi of those rajputs. Vikramaditya tried to kill her by adding poison to Krishna Charnamrit, sending a snake and doing many other efforts. But he failed always because Lord KRISHNA saved her. Due to all these, MEERAn left CHITTORE for her TIRTH YATRA. She traveled at many places like MERTA, MATHURA, VRINDAVAN dancing and sining KRISHNA Bhajans which were her own compositions called DOHAS.

Years after she reached at DWARKA the place of Lord KRISHNA. In the year 1546, ruler of CHITTOR Udai Singh sent a group of delegates to respectfully bring MEERAn back to CHITTORE. MEERAn didn't want to comeback; she prayed to Lord KRISHNA that she wanted to stay in DWARKA. Finally she disappeared by merging herself in the STATUE OF KRISHNA at a temple in DWARKA with the blessings of Lord KRISHNA.

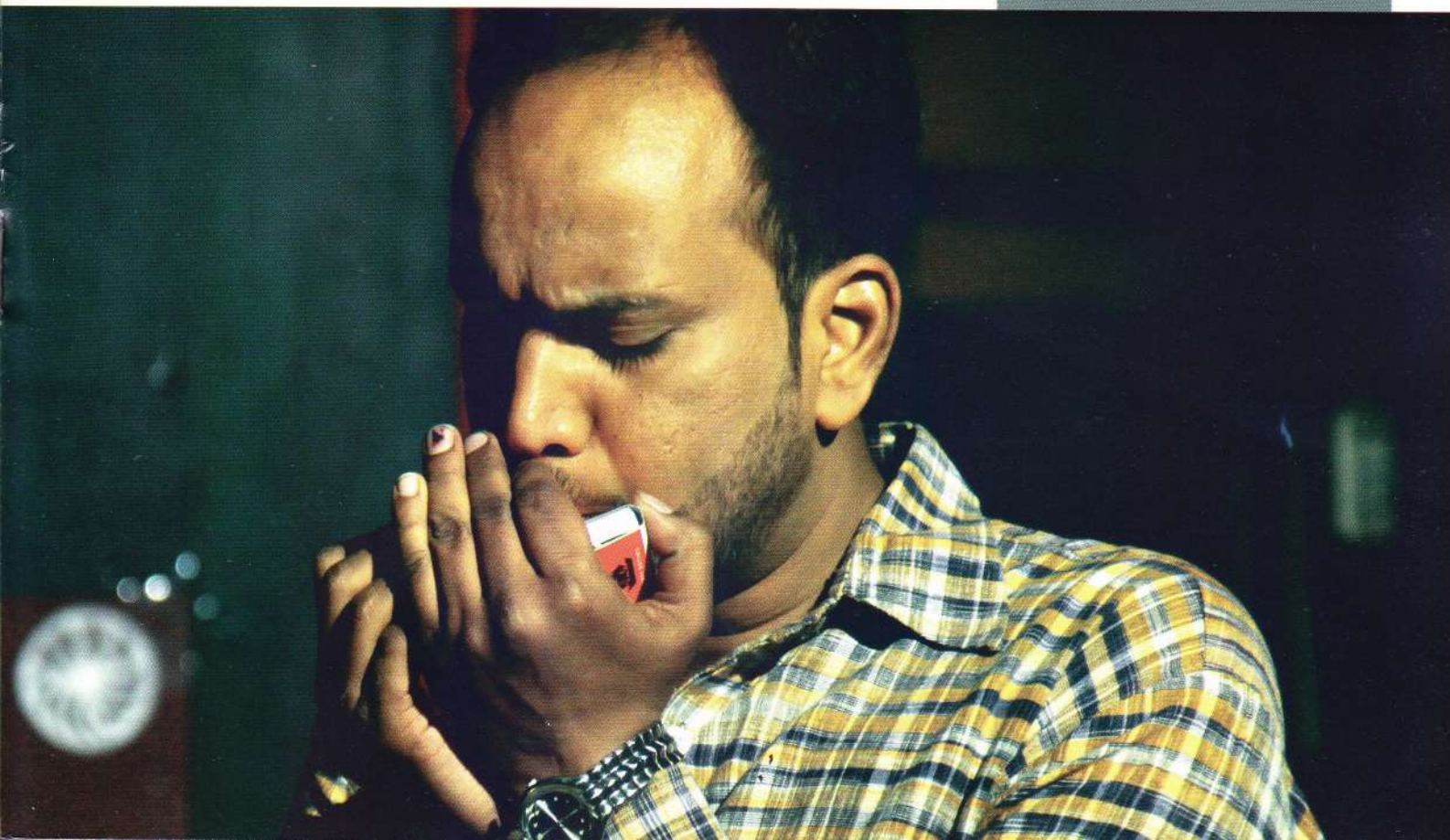

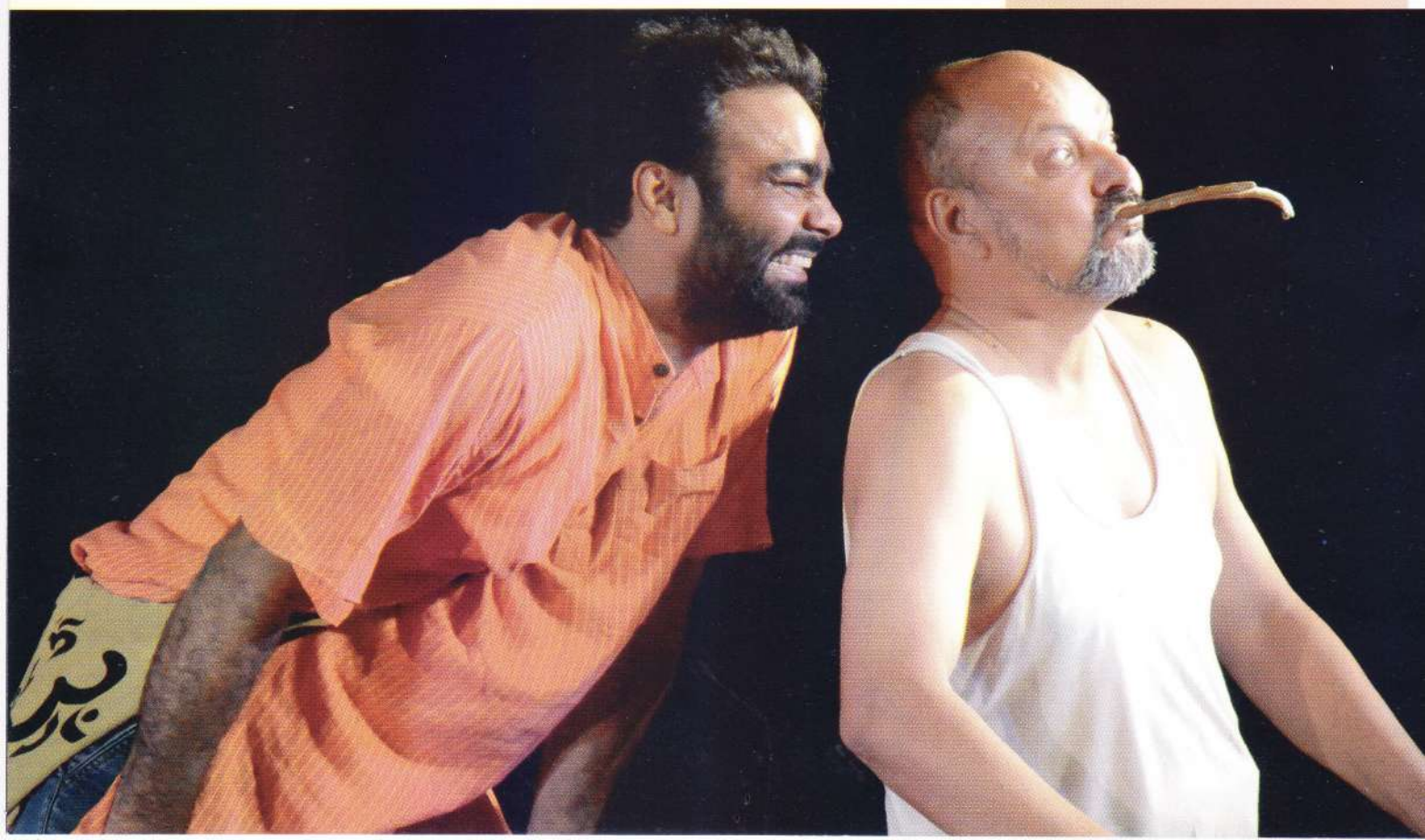

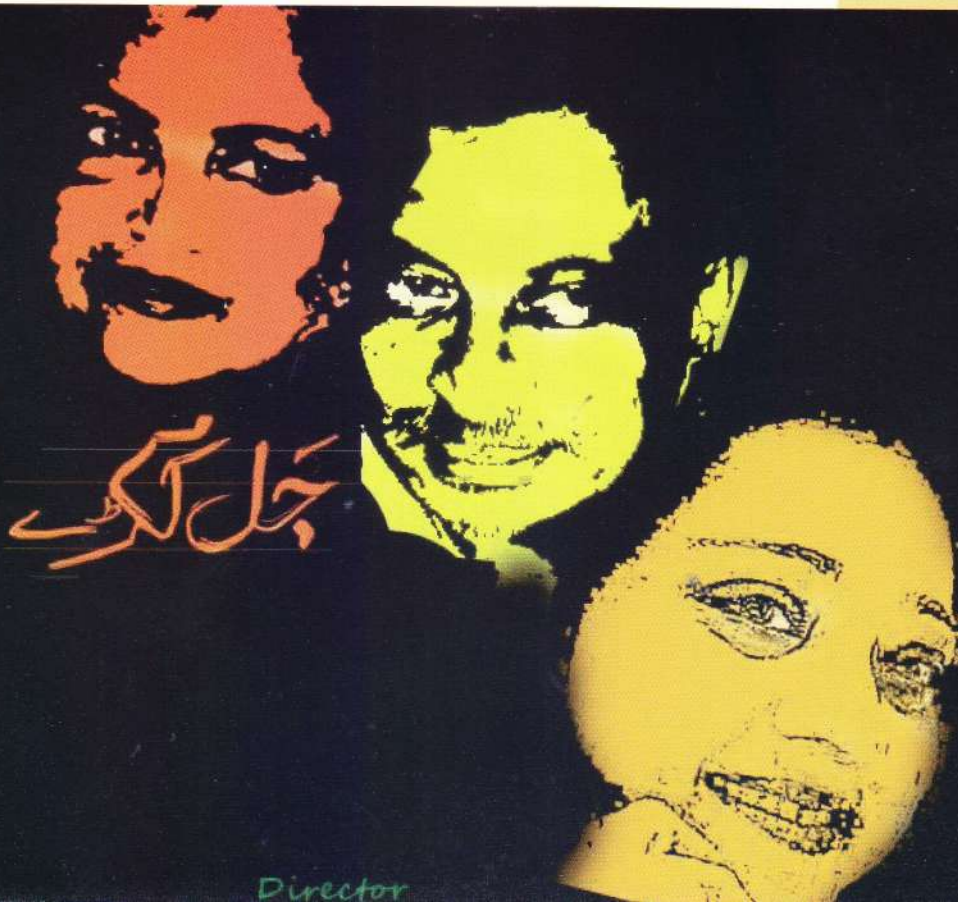

कनुप्रिया की सारी प्रतिक्रियाएँ उसी तन्मयता की विभिन्न स्थितियाँ हैं।

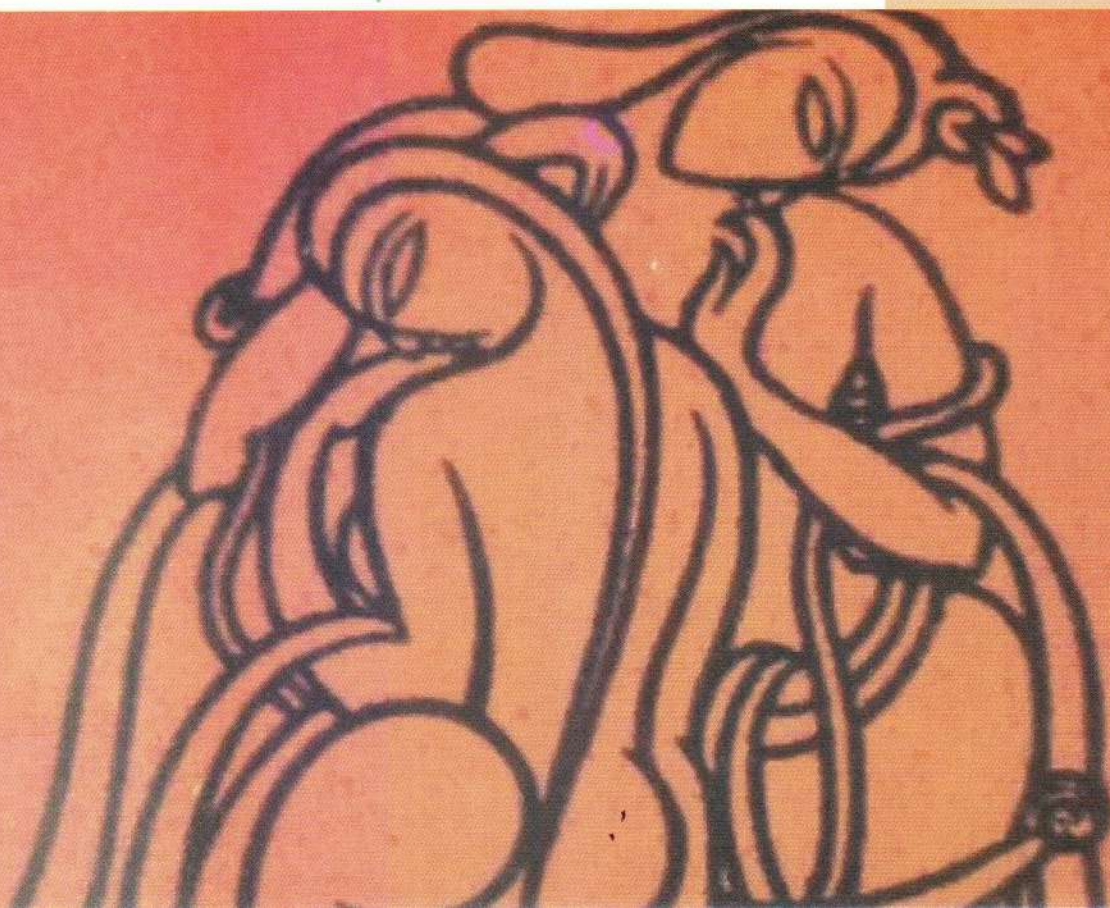
